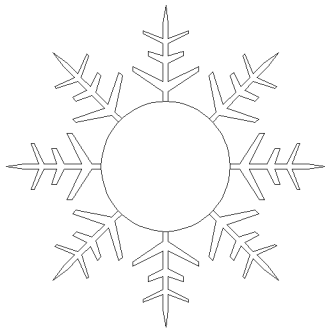
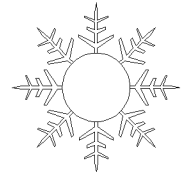
For me personally, it marks a year free of major medical issues, travels safely negotiated and fragile family health showing stability—things I fervently wish for others.



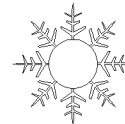
Since we are a people-centered organization, the year has been rewarding for the relationships developed and gratifying in terms of helping those in need.
